REPORT OF ACCIDENT/INCIDENT

(include who, what, when, where, and how)

Employee was getting thumb tacks out of filing cabinet when a tack flew up and across employees eye, scratching it.

I was driving, when a dog hell bent on catching a car in the opposite lane ran directly into my front grille. It was his fault, and I wasted him. The owner acknowledged the dogs own fault, so he let the thing drop, as I did, and hopefully everyone else will also, o.k.?

While driving, a white tail deer emerged from a wooded area to his right and ran into the vehicle's path. Crunch.

Nine workers and myself were unloading bleachers on the baseball field. We took the bleachers off the trailer and was about to put it down. I said, "o.k., let it drop here." Everyone let go except me and the angle iron on the top seat struck me on top of the head causing a laceration and a mild concussion.

As I was repairing a fire hydrant plug, my foot slipped and the fire hydrant hit me on the knee and just below the knee.

Truck backed into stump causing damage to passenger side of cab just behind the door.

Corrective Action Taken or Planned: Driver was cussed out the day of the incident.

I parked the vehicle on the side of the road. When I tried to leave, the vehicle slipped on the wet grass into the ditch against a small tree.

Corrective Action Taken or Planned: Stay out of the ditch.

Entering traffic from small driveway, when owners fence caught on the government truck and damaged the left rear side panel of the truck.

While on duty as a law enforcement officer, I was trying to arrest a subject who had been driving reckless and was believed to be intoxicated. Subject had abandoned his car and ran into some brush, where there is tall weeds, a hill, and lots of trees and green vegetation. While looking for this individual, I accidentally fell into an outdoor toilet hole which was covered over by weeds. This hole was 3 or 4 feet deep.

Coming out of garage to ramp, headed for street - car coming down ramp at entrance to garage at the same time I was turning right onto ramp. I turned too close to wall and wham! Here I am in trouble hitting the wall with my rear door and rear wheel, damaging the chrome on rear door and rear wheel well.

10:00-Employee "went to do a three point turn in the street" and backed into a parked station wagon on the right side.

Station wagon is moved.

11:30-Employee (brother of first employee) in same route of travel "was backing up - doing a three point turn" and backed into a parked station wagon on the left side.

That's right - the same station wagon.

This is the third time vehicle has been towed in because of self ignition; if I should receive serious injury in a conflagration because of inept engineering or the use of gas station mechanics instead of more expensive authorized repairmen, my estate will be very bitter.

Sept. '84

In falling, I tried to catch myself with my right hand. Most of the weight was on my right thumb. My thumb immediately began to hurt. I could move it, but there was pain and swelling. It appears that I sprung my right thumb.

Individual was in the restroom stall and when he was done he tried to open the door when he found (or thought) it was stuck. Another individual helped by crawling under the door. They both pushed on the door (the wrong way) when the hinges were torn from the wall and the door fell on the first individual's foot.

Employee was cutting cable off the door with a blow torch and a piece of melting metal fell and burnt a hole through his pants leg and it dropped into his boot, which burnt his foot on the arch area. His immediate reaction was to remove his boot and he was hopping around and landed on the same foot which resulted in the broken ankle.

Employees were cutting weeds. The area is covered in poison ivy. Even though long sleeve shirts were worn, the dreaded poison ivy attacked their bodies.

Large table was placed by door. Upon opening and walking through door, was struck by that table. Table weight approximately 190 lbs. Table first struck me against the knee, then fell further and struck me against the ankle causing two large contusions and abrasions.

The vehicle was occupied three times at the time of the accident.

Employee was coming down stairs with vacuum cleaner. Lost balance on step - hit step with right ankle. Sprong right ankle.

Plane spotted house on fire and fire department was notified and responded. The fire department got the fire under control, the structure totally destroyed. Individual and his girl friend were working on a bed at the north end of the residence when he noticed sparks outside the window. He stated that at taking a second look, the inside wall and ceiling of the bedroom were on fire. He and his girl friend ran to the front of the residence and began to gather items before exiting the front door. They stood outside as the building was totally burned. The cause has not been located.
